Parking outside school

All our children have the right to expect a safe journey to and from school so please do not block pavements or otherwise obstruct the entrance and exit gates. We have received complaints about the way some cars are being parked when collecting and dropping off children. We are very concerned that illegal parking is putting the safety of all our learners at risk when they are crossing the road outside the school.

When it rains the traffic outside school is even worse! If you are using your car to drop off your child please do not stop in the road (double-park) to drop off your children.

Goud Street is a ONE WAY and many parents ignore the one-way rule (even though there are street signs). Firstly, this is illegal and secondly it causes traffic problems. If parents drive with caution and obey the laws of the road – their children will also have more respect for traffic laws and for those who travel our roads!

LET'S ALL CHEER FOR FATHERS!



We wish all our fathers a wonderful Father's Day on Sunday the 16th June. Father's Day is celebrated worldwide to recognize the contribution that fathers and father figures make to the lives of their children. This day celebrates fatherhood and male parenting. Although it is celebrated on a variety of dates worldwide, many countries observe this day on the third Sunday in June. Did you know? A customary day for the celebration of fatherhood in Catholic Europe is known to date back to at least the Middle Ages, and it is observed on March 19, as the feast day of Saint Joseph, who is referred to as the fatherly Nouritor Domini ("Nourisher of the Lord") in Catholicism and "the putative father of Jesus" in southern European tradition.

Enrol for 2020—Spaces are limited !!

Enrolments are still open for Grade RR, R and Grade 1 for 2020. Enrolments for Grade 1 at CityKidz Primary School are in high demand and we have limited spaces available for Grade 1. Current Grade R parents need to confirm if they will be at CityKidz next year as we are already placing new registrations on a waiting list.

If you have a child who is eligible to come to school in 2020 for Grade RR (Grade RR: The age is 3yrs turning 4yrs by 30 June in the year of admission) and for Grade R (Grade R: The age is 4 yrs turning five by 30 June in the year of admission), we are accepting enrolments now. The language of learning and teaching at CityKidz Primary is ENGLISH, therefore it is imperative that your child be able to speak and understand English. Please be aware that the First additional language (FAL) from Grade R to Grade 7 is Afrikaans.

To enrol you will need to either collect a registration form from the office or download it from our website (www.citykidz.co.za).

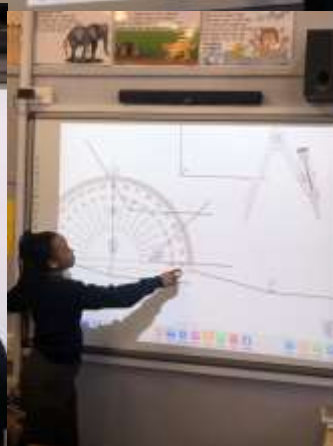
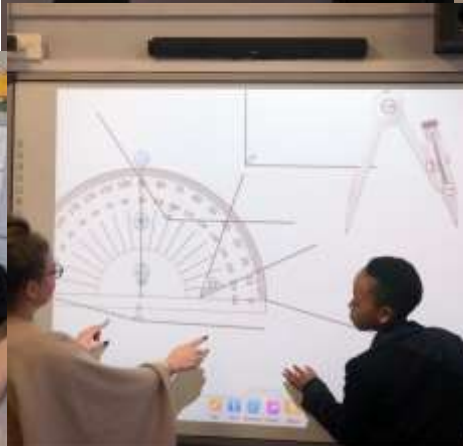
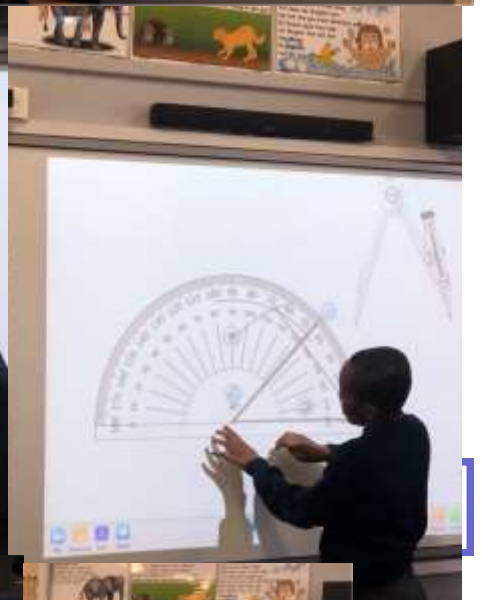
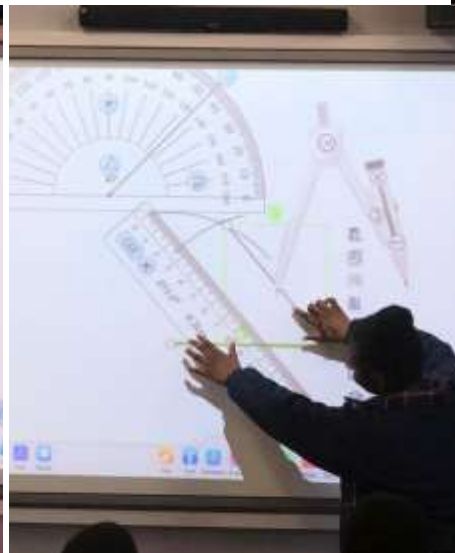
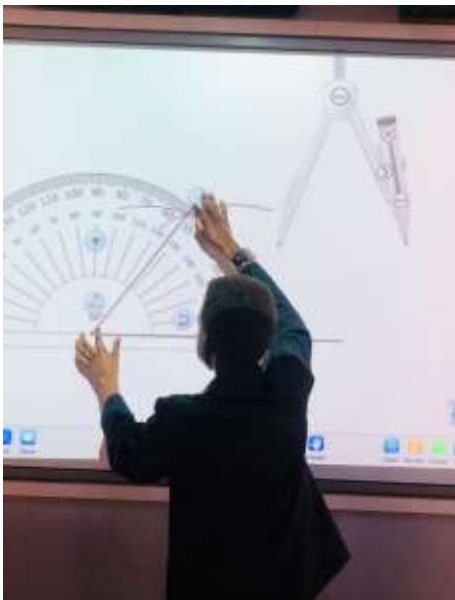
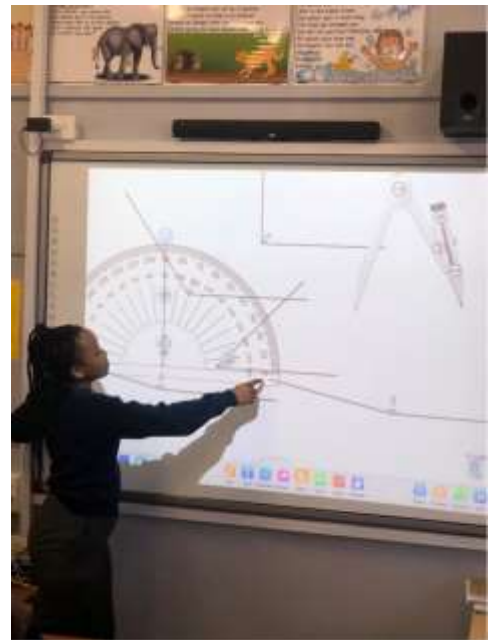
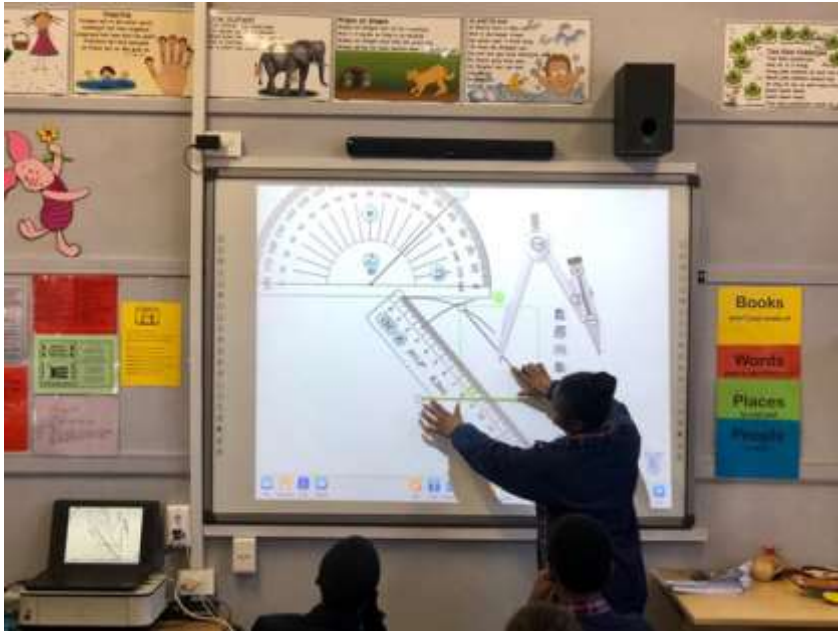
