## Grade 1 Article- Autumn

Grade 1s had so much fun constructing their Autumn trees for Life Skills with recycled material.

The learners certainly had some fun bonding with each other after the holidays. They show-cased their ability to use their imaginations and produce creative masterpieces whilst still learning about the different seasons in a year. Autumn is one of the four seasons of the year and is the time of year that transitions summer into winter. Red, yellow, orange and brown are the colours of the leaves before they fall to the ground. Along with the tree leaves changing colour, the temperature grows colder, plants stop making food, animals prepare for the long months ahead, and the daylight starts growing shorter.

In the Autumn as the weather grows colder, many plants stop producing food. The short amount of sunlight makes the leaves begin to change to yellow, orange, and red colour before turning brown and falling off. The evergreen trees do not lose their leaves because they naturally produce a wax cover on their needles that protects them from freezing.

We will start to see the animals begin to store food in their nests and dens, like squirrels who gather acorns before winter. Some animals, like bears, eat extra food to build up extra fat on their bodies, while others will grow warmer coats of fur to stay warm all winter. The animals will find a private, hidden place to stay safe, warm, and dry while they sleep through the cold months.


